'LETTERS' - A MOVING PRODUCTION

On April 19th, I had the pleasure of attending not one but two performances of 'Letters' by DramaOneVan. Although the play was in Cantonese with English subtitles, after only a couple of minutes I barely noticed I was reading at all. I was totally engrossed in the emotional performances of the actors who were committed to their roles as family members and individuals grappling with issues of aging and family relationships. Raw emotion does not need to be translated and I could feel their guilt, sadness and confusion through their emotive performances. Those intense feelings were balanced with some very humourous sequences, including a wonderful scene about the Family Respite Centre where I clearly recognized some of our clients and staff and couldn't help but feel inspired to continue to support the excellent care provided by our staff to enable families to have some respite from their unrelenting home responsibilities. In the final moments of the play, when the children come to terms with the choices they have made, I noticed many around me wiping tears and I know the drama inspired many to go home and call their loved ones. We could not be more thankful to have been asked to be involved in this production. Sometimes a unique way of looking at the work we do can inspire more people to join in supporting and helping to create supportive solutions to enable seniors to remain in their homes longer.

I would also like to take this opportunity to personally thank once again the Director, Peter Poon, and May Soo in addition to all the other actors, volunteers, generous sponsors and more than 1000 theatre attendees who made this production possible. Proceeds from both performances will be used to continue to support and grow our Meals on Wheels program in Vancouver and Richmond. While more than \$55,000 was raised, as importantly the drama created more awareness in the community and undoubtedly will inspire more people to volunteer and to give back.


