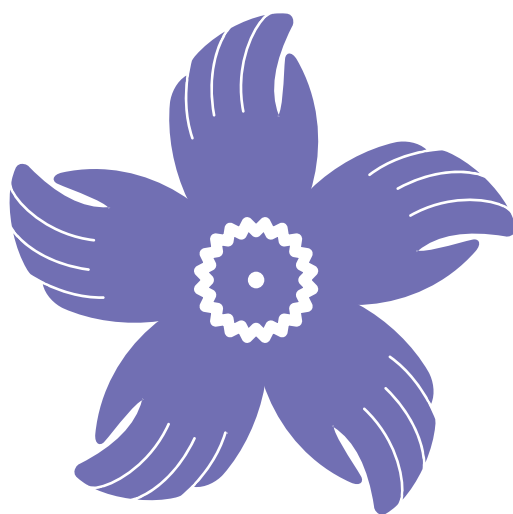

2010-2011 Year in Review from Board President Tom Chambers and Executive Director Inge Schamborzki

The Health and Home Care Society of BC (HHCSBC) is pleased to report that we have completed another year with success. We are celebrating our 112th year of providing preventative and supportive health care services tailored to the communities we serve; first as a founding branch of the Victorian Order of Nurses (1898), and since 2006 as HHCSBC. Our organization's vision of a future of seniors living independently in their own homes would not be possible without the heartfelt commitment of our qualified staff and dedicated volunteers who make the following programs possible:

Our volunteers have been delivering **Western Meals on Wheels** since 1967, and **Chinese Meals on Wheels** since 1996. In 2010 alone, we delivered a total

of 100,119 meals in Vancouver and Richmond, and this need continues to grow.

Our **Family Respite Centre (FRC)** offers temporary support to caregivers of loved ones with physical and/or mental frailties within the Vancouver Coastal Health region. The FRC is a

secure, home-like environment where nursing services and recreational and therapeutic activities are offered within an Adult Day Program (since 1979) and Overnight Respite program which also includes palliative respite (since 2000).

For 11 years, our **Community Integration Project** has been helping individuals with disabilities make the transition from rehabilitation to independent living. Our specially designed housing units and social services help clients achieve physical independence and social integration. This year we were able to support eight individuals through this program.

Since 1997, our Registered Nurses have been providing customized **Health Promotion**

Services (HPS) such as immunization clinics, health education and screening tests throughout the province, to both corporate clients and individuals within their homes. HPS operates as a social enterprise in that all revenue generated is used to directly support our charitable programs, such as Meals on Wheels and Family Respite.

Highlights from the 2010 - 2011 Fiscal Year:

We are thrilled to honour one of our amazing volunteers, Donna Cook, for 40 years of dedicated service with our Meals on Wheels program. Donna was recognized alongside 50 other volunteers and staff at our Annual Volunteer and Staff Recognition Tea. We extend

thanks to all of our committed volunteers and staff, and particularly to Donna for this landmark achievement.

In a bid to offer greater variety and convenience for our clients, we launched our first-ever Meals on Wheels breakfast menu in June 2010. The menu offers five delicious selections and includes popular classics such as French toast and omelette. The breakfast items are delivered frozen to enable clients to heat and enjoy them at their convenience. Additionally, in August 2010 we increased the number of daily frozen entrée options from one to four, again offering greater selection for our clients.

In February 2011, we hosted the 3rd Annual Meals on Wheels Fundraising Dinner and Auction. We are incredibly pleased to report that with the support of our community, we

were able to raise \$20,000 toward our Western and Chinese Meals on Wheels programs in Vancouver and Richmond.

We have become aware of the increasing diversity present within the population of guests at our Family Respite Centre. We recognize the necessity to respond to this by developing an equally diverse syndicate of qualified staff and volunteers.

The HHCSBC website received a complete makeover this year with the intention to provide a more inviting and user-friendly experience for visitors. We are excited about this new look and encourage you to take a peek!

The 2010 – 2011 flu season was much calmer, so to speak, following the year of the H1N1 pandemic. This year, our HPS flu program offered a choice of two flu vaccines: the

traditional seasonal flu shot, Vaccigrip, and the new micro-needle vaccine, Intanza - ideal for individuals with a phobia of needles.

We would like to utilize this opportunity to give thanks to the Board, all of our staff and volunteers, and our donors, who make it possible to provide these invaluable services to our community.

We also offer our tremendous appreciation to our program partners: Fair Haven United Church Homes Society, the Nissan Canada Foundation, the Vancouver Foundation, St. George's Place Society, Vancouver Coastal Health, and the financial assistance and generous support of the Province of British Columbia. 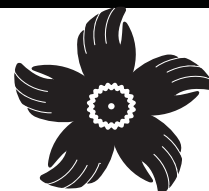

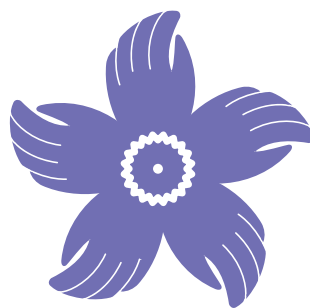
