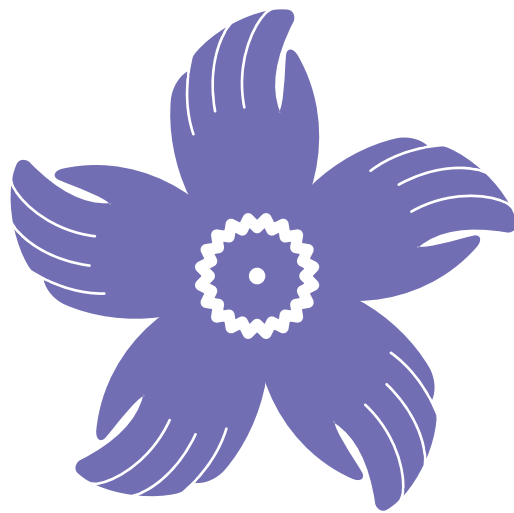

2011-2012 Program Overview

The Health & Home Care Society of BC (CARE BC) is an independent, Vancouver-based, not-for-profit organization and a founding member of the Victorian Order of Nurses. Since 1898 CARE BC has supported British Columbians with health care initiatives tailored to the communities served. When, in 2006, VON Canada restructured into a single, administrative national entity, Care BC's Society elected to become an independent organization to best serve British Columbians and adopted its current name at that time. This tradition of caring is continued with preventive and supportive health services that keep people healthy and living in the comfort of their homes and communities.

Since 1967, CARE BC has operated the **Meals on Wheels (MOW)** program in Vancouver and Richmond. In addition to delivering a hot western or Chinese meal, the Society's 400 volunteers also offer the comfort of a friendly visit and the reassurance of an informal check on the safety and well-being of the 1000 meal recipients who last year received a total of 100,000 meals. In 1996, CARE BC launched one of Canada's first Chinese MOW programs. In addition to the dedicated volunteers who serve approximately 250 Western meals each weekday, 150 authentic Chinese meals are also

delivered by Chinese-speaking volunteers. The majority of the MOW clients are over the age of 80. Thirteen percent are 90 years of age or older. Sixty-five percent of the MOW clients live alone.

Our **Health Promotion Services** have also enhanced the wellbeing of British Columbia's employers and employees since 1997 by offering customized workplace, home and community wellness programs, as well as immunizations and screening clinics. The revenue generated from this social enterprise supports Meals on Wheels.

Our purpose-built, **Family Respite Centre (FRC)** opened in south Vancouver in 2002. The program was established to support caregivers by offering them a much needed and well-deserved "break" from caring for their loved ones. The FRC is a homelike environment where primarily seniors with mental and/or physical frailties receive temporary day and/or overnight care. The majority return home to live with their families. Last year 250 guests benefited from the support of the FRC's dedicated nursing staff, advanced recreational and therapeutic programs and the opportunity to socialize with other guests, staff and volunteers.

Since 2000, with the support of a part time social worker and the invaluable resource of two appropriately adapted

apartments in Vancouver, the **Community Integration Project** was established to assist individuals with physical disabilities and/or brain injuries to once again achieve physical independence and community social integration. By adapting their housing and daily living needs, the majority of these individuals are supported to return to live within their own homes and communities

We would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge and thank all of our volunteers, including our Board members; donors; and staff, for their invaluable contributions to the provision of the community services previously outlined. We furthermore extend our appreciation to our program partners including: Fair Haven United Church Homes Society, the Nissan Canada Foundation, the Vancouver Foundation, St. George's Place Society, Vancouver Coastal Health and the financial assistance and generous support of the Province of British Columbia. 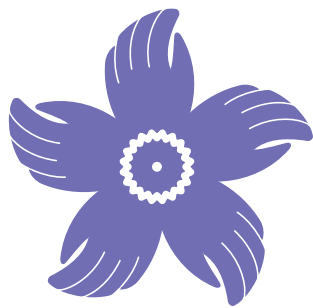
