### **Dress Code Policy: Family Respite Centre (FRC)**

The Health and Home Care Society of BC (Care BC) requests that volunteers comply with the following dress code when volunteering in the Family Respite Centre (FRC) or acting as a representative of the organization. By following the dress code volunteers will be safe and at the same time present a good image to clients and the community.

#### **Policy:**

- Volunteers shall dress appropriately for the conditions of their volunteer role and to safely perform their duties.
  - Volunteers may wear jeans, casual pants or comfortable clothing of their choice providing it is clean and appropriate.
  - Volunteers should wear closed toe shoes while performing their volunteer duties.
  - Volunteers should not wear clothing with offensive branding or slogans visible.
  - Volunteers should not wear perfumes or fragrances while volunteering.
  - Volunteers will wear their identification badge at all times.
  - Care BC cannot be responsible for any clothing damaged or stained while volunteering.
  - Volunteers should wear aprons provided when appropriate.
