Dress Code Policy: Meals on Wheels (MOW)

The Health and Home Care Society of BC (Care BC) requests that volunteers comply with the following dress code when delivering meals to clients or acting as a representative of the organization.

Policy:

- Volunteers shall dress appropriately for the condition of their volunteer role and to safely perform their duties.
 - Volunteers may wear jeans, casual pants or comfortable clothing of their choice providing it is clean and appropriate.
 - Volunteers should wear closed toe shoes while performing their volunteer duties.
 - Volunteers should not wear clothing with offensive branding or slogans visible.
 - Volunteers should not wear heavy perfumes or scents.
 - Meals on Wheels volunteers will wear or carry their identification badge with them at all times.
 - Care BC cannot be responsible for any clothing damaged or stained while volunteering.
